

### **Vaccination Information:**

**Tetanus** – It is a single shot that is good for 10 years.

**Hepatitis A** – Is a series of two shots. The first part is given, and you must wait 6-12 months to receive the second part. After both parts, it is good for life.

(For children under 18, the doctor that we use to give vaccinations on campus does not have this vaccination in a child's dosage. For a child the dosage is different but it is still a two part shot.)

**Hepatitis B** – This is a series of 3 shots. One month after the first shot is given, you receive the second shot. Six months later you get the third. After all three parts, you are good for life. (If you have not had a complete set of three shots, you have a few options:

1. You can have your blood drawn to see the percentage of the vaccination in your blood or
2. You can start over and receive all three shots again.

**Typhoid** – This shot is good for 2 years. If you prefer, you can get pills from your physician. The doctor that comes to Fellowship only gives the shots.

**Yellow Fever** – This is a single shot that is good for 10 years.

**Mengicoccal** - This is a single shot that is good for life. (If there is an epidemic in the country that you are traveling to, it may be suggested that you get a booster.)
